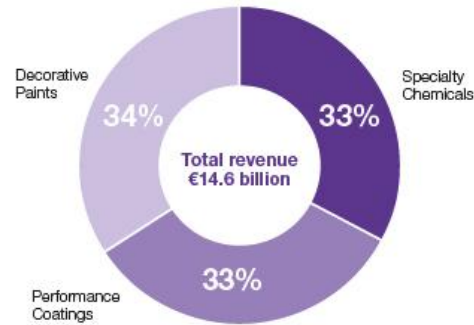

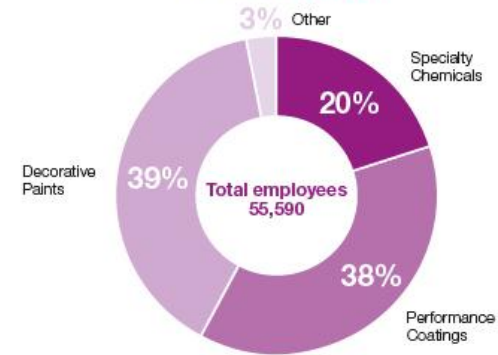

Revenue (in billions) €14.6



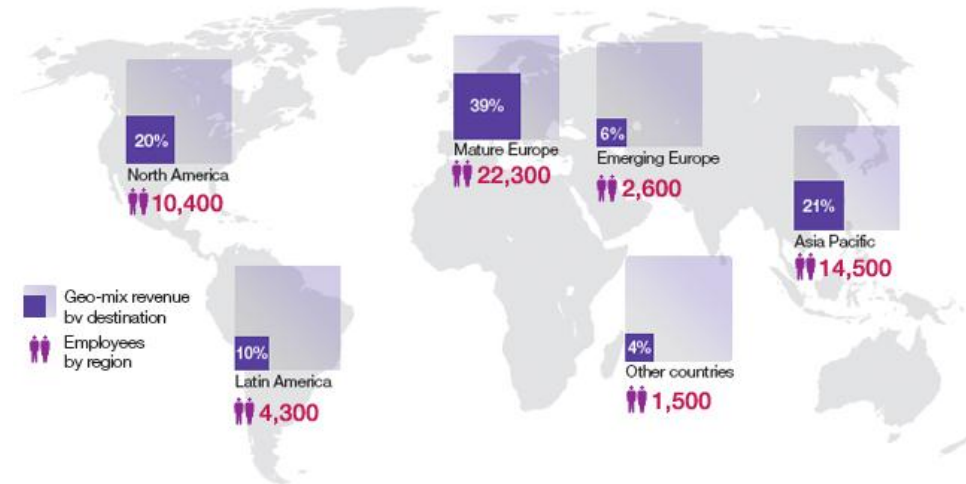
Revenue by Business Area

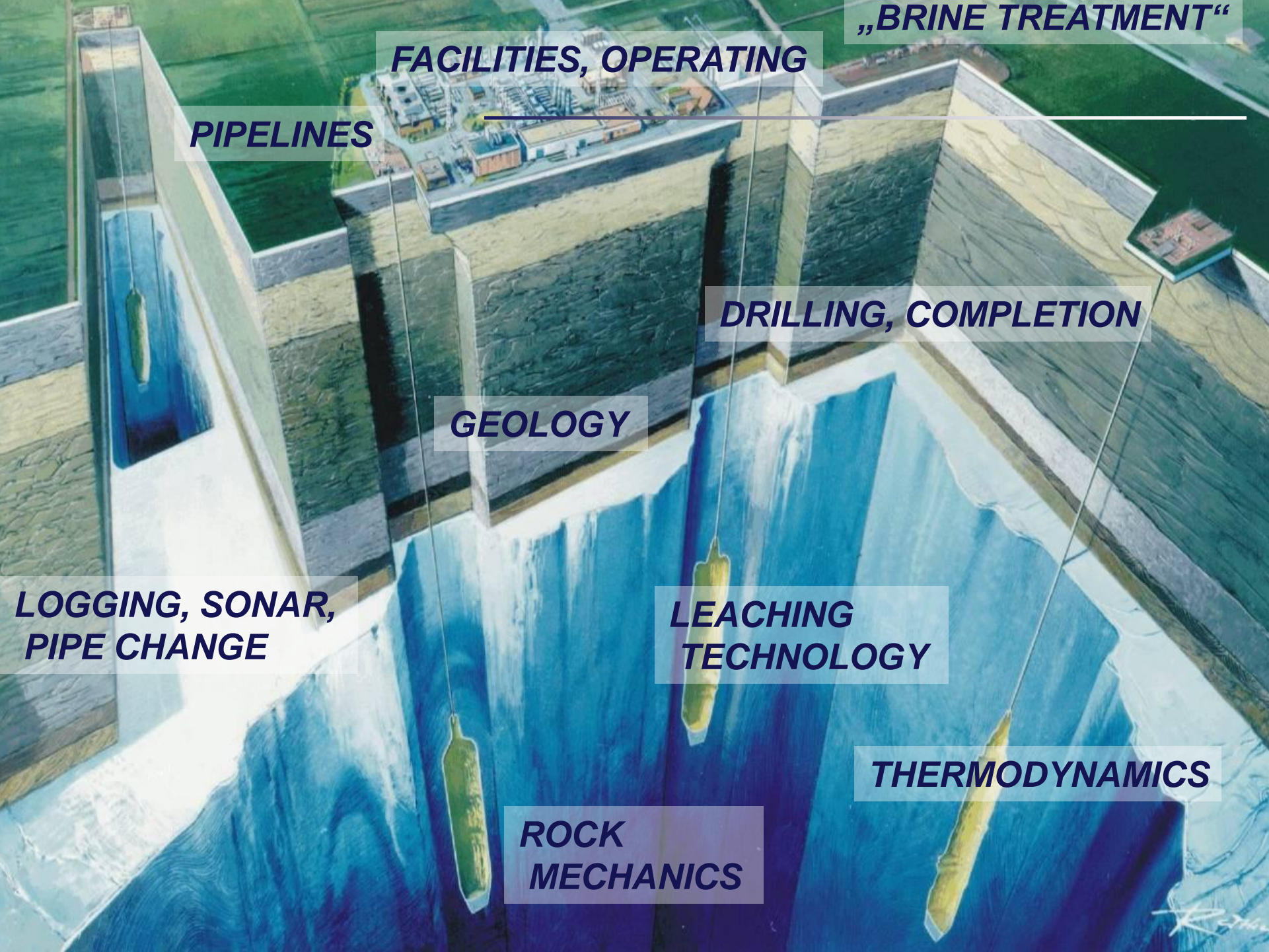
